What are you going to do exactly?

- Package goods in the right way including weighing, measuring, labeling;

- Prepare outbound orders according to established procedures;
- Operates the equipment, including scanners, in a flexible manner to achieve the goods flow and the administrative actions;
- Administrates the standard proces accurately in the operational systems (booking inbound shipments, confirming outbound shipments);
- Identifies (quality) problems, monitors problem situations and improves them in consultation with the supervisor;
